David Cooley 1960-2009



The SETLA scholarship program officially changed its name to the SETLA/David Cooley Memorial Scholarship in 2009 to honor the memory of our colleague and friend, David Cooley. Cooley, a retired Air Force lieutenant colonel, served as a F-117 and F-22 test pilot for Lockheed-Martin. Cooley had a significant career as a versatile test pilot. He had a large effect on the test flight community in the high desert as a trainer and mentor of future test pilots. Cooley flew a long list of aircraft that included the F-111, F-15, F-117 and F-22. He was calm, cool, collected. His love of flying was infectious. He was a consummate professional, a true leader, and an inspiration to everyone.
